










The slippery, sneaky enemy came again. It tried to tangle up the heart.

Dear Safe Adult,

I wrote this story for the son of a good friend, who struggles with overwhelming and hard feelings about his story. I wanted him to understand no matter how attacked his heart might feel, or how loud the voices are, God is more. He's more big, more strong, more present, more powerful.

I taught him to say this prayer when he felt darkness:	
Dear Jesus, I am	(scared, confused, lonely).
Help my heart to feel Your peace. Come for me. Amen.	

It's my prayer you can have your eyes open to the children around you who need discipled with the same truth.
